### Get your home ready for a BC Flood

- ✓ Review what your insurance covers
- ✓ Keep documents in waterproof containers
- ✓ Save digital copies of important paperwork

**Create grab-and-go bags for each member of your family in case you have to evacuate.**

**Don't forget your pets when preparing for a potential flood. Start by including them in your emergency plan by adding:**

- ✓ Their name and breed
- ✓ Microchip number
- ✓ Vaccination history
- ✓ A photo for identification

**Your pets will be counting on you if you have to evacuate due to flooding. Build them a grab-and-go bag that includes:**

- ✓ Leash and pet carrier
- ✓ Food and water with collapsible dishes
- ✓ Treats and a favourite toy
- ✓ Copy of vaccination records
- ✓ Medications
- ✓ Photos of them for identification
