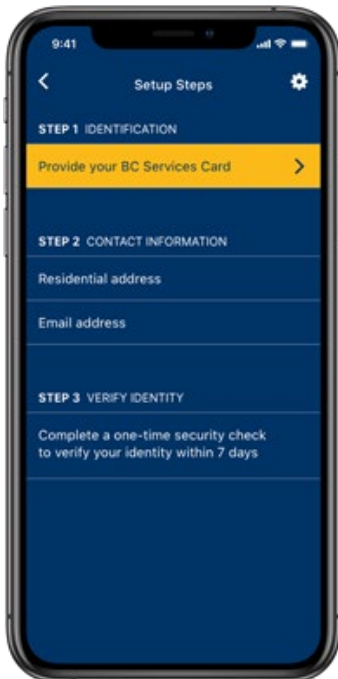

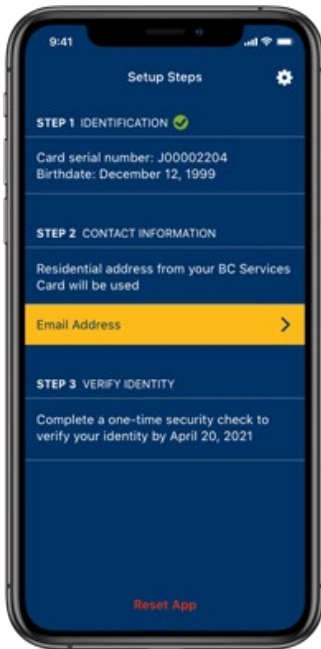
- Get the [BC Services Card app](#)
- Open the app
- When prompted, it's recommended you allow [notifications](#)
- With notifications enabled, you'll be able to remember a [paired device](#) to use the next time you log in
- Read and accept the [BC Login Service Terms of Use](#)
- Review [privacy information](#) and learn how to [protect your device](#)
- **You will need a locking code on your phone when setting up the app - keep locking code on your phone until your ERA file is complete**
- **You must have a valid BC Care Card to be eligible for E-transfer supports**

(enhanced driver's license)

Step 1: Provide your valid ID



- ▶ Indigenous status card
- ▶ Passport
- ▶ Driver's license & Enhanced driver's license
- ▶ Canadian military ID card
- ▶ Government-issued ID card & Government enhanced ID card
- ▶ Health card Canadian citizenship card (issued before February 1, 2012)
- ▶ Canadian permanent resident card
- ▶ US permanent resident card (green card)



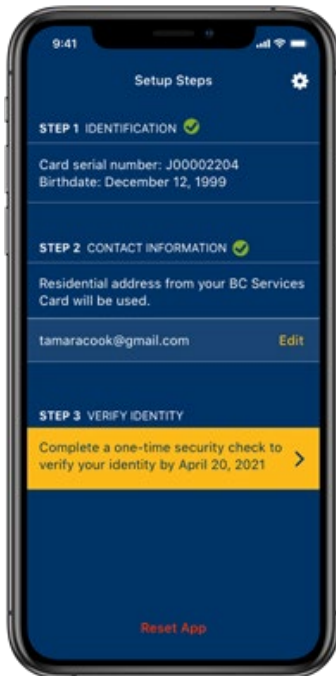
Step 2: Provide your email address

Your email address will be used to contact you about your logins or changes to your account.

You will be asked to confirm your email address by entering a code that is sent to your email account to:

- Make sure you entered the email address correctly
- Prove you have access to that email account

Step 3: Verify your identity



Complete a one-time security check to verify your identity.

- Verify your identity by video
- Verify your identity in person at a BC Services offices

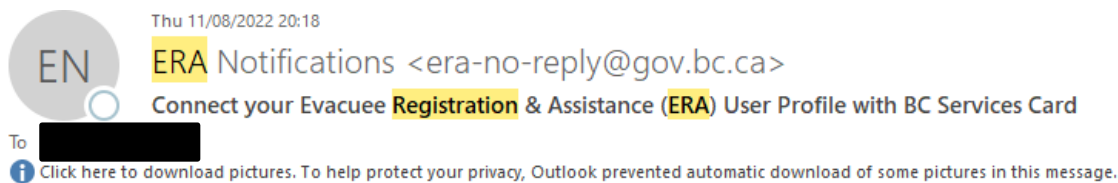
Verify your identity as soon as possible as it may take time to receive confirmation.

Once you receive confirmation that you identify is verified, **the final step is to link your card.**

Link your BC Service Card to your ESS file

If you have registered with ESS, you will have received an email requesting that you link your services card to your ESS file.

Email will look like this....
